1. Opening Remarks

- President Hugh Aerts opened the meeting by addressing challenges with updating corporate records:
 - o Online registration of amended articles and bylaws was unsuccessful.
 - Hard copy submissions were also rejected.
 - Board member updates failed to save; external help was sought from John Goudy.

2. Integrity Agreement Planning

- The current Integrity Date agreement expires February 28, 2027.
- Since Union Gas is owned by Enbridge, the group must:
 - Research alternative agreements.
 - Decide whether to negotiate collectively or individually.
- President expressed concern about his capacity to lead this effort due to:
 - Municipal council duties.
 - o Personal fatigue.
 - Need to reassess his role and commitment.

3. Subcommittee Proposal

- A subcommittee may be formed to handle Integrity Agreement preparations.
- President anticipates Enbridge will aim for minimal concessions.

• Preparations expected to begin in 2026.

4. CAEPLA Donations

- President proposed reconsidering donations to CAEPLA.
- Decision deferred to group consensus.

5. Approval of Previous Minutes

- Copies of previous meeting minutes were confirmed received.
- Motion to approve:

Outcome: Approved unanimously

6. Financial Report Discussion

- Emphasis on understanding easement rules, especially for gas lines.
- Key issues raised:
 - Tile drainage complications across gas lines.
 - o Pipeline company's responsibility for drainage and outlet provision.
 - Case discussed: land trapped due to pipeline, only drainage path crosses gas line.
 - o Delays and costs incurred due to contractor wait times.
 - Example: \$6,000 cost for 6-inch tile replacement.
- Recommendation:
 - Submit itemized bills to pipeline company for all incurred costs.
 - o Clarify maintenance responsibilities under specific agreements.
 - o Note: Not all municipalities (e.g., City of London) operate under same terms.

7. Elections
